## Current News from Rotary International website:

Rotaract clubs around the world are celebrating World Rotaract Week, 8-14 March, honoring the charter of the first club in North Carolina, USA.

As of 28 February, Rotarians have [raised about \\$114.5 million](#) for Rotary’s US\$200 Million Challenge. These contributions will help Rotary raise \$200 million to match \$355 million in challenge grants received from the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation. The resulting \$555 million will directly support immunization campaigns in developing countries, where polio continues to infect and paralyze children. March 6th kicked off a 19 country campaign in West and Central Africa to immunize 85 million children under the age of 5 against polio. Funding included \$30 million from Rotary International.
